

Thomasville Habitat for Humanity has the ability to refuse any donation at our discretion. We ask that all ReStore donors use their best judgment when bringing items to the ReStore for resale as we are a *resale retail outlet*, not a recycling center.

Appliances

Appliances must be missing no parts, clean and in full working order. We cannot accept appliances older than 10 years. Vintage and antique items accepted provided they work and are in excellent condition.

- Air conditioners/dehumidifiers/humidifiers/air filtration *new*
- Dishwashers *Less than 3 years old*
- Microwave ovens
- Ranges and oven *Gas and electric*
- Range hoods/tops
- Refrigerators and freezers
- Small appliances *Toasters, blenders, juicers, mixers, coffee makers, etc. Less than 7 years old .*
- Vacuum cleaners
- Washers and dryers

Architectural items

- No items with lead paint
- Aged barn wood
- Columns
- Leaded glass panels
- Mantels
- Porch posts
- Shiplap siding
- Stained glass windows
- Wrought iron gates

Cabinets

Preferably wood in good to excellent condition. Must be complete with all doors and drawers attached and free of extensive damage or wear from stains or water damage, no nails or screws sticking out.

- Individual pieces or full sets of cabinets

- Bathroom vanities
- Kitchen cabinets
- Medicine cabinets

Counter Tops

- Laminate, Corian®, granite and Silestone®
- At least 6' long without cutouts. *No size requirements if accompanies matching cabinet. No chips, cracks, or other damage.*

Ceiling Tiles and Panels

All types: acoustic, metal, facade, dimension, surface mount, drop-in; new only

- Acoustic tiles *in original packaging marked with either manufacture date or containing the words no asbestos. Must be manufactured after 1980, previously manufactured products will not be accepted.*
- Drop-in grid pieces *full lengths, no damage, no rust;*

Doors

All interior, exterior, screen, and security doors must be clean and in new or like-new condition. No rotting wood, delaminating wood, cracks, lead paint, deep scratches, broken glass. Please remove all hardware except on screen, storm and security doors and bag all parts to donate separately.

- Bi-fold doors *louvered doors must have all louvers intact*
- Doors *pre-hung or door slabs*
- French doors *must be paired together*
- Interior doors *wood, hinged, pocket or bypass*
- exterior doors *wood, metal or fiberglass*
- Hollow core doors *must be free of puncture damage*
- Patio/sliding glass doors *must be vinyl clad only with all tracking and glass intact with no damage or fogging. Thermal glass only*
- Storm and security doors *Include frames/hardware.*



Electrical

Electrical components must be functional and in good condition, no outdated electrical hardware.

- Load centers, breakers and fuses *new*
- Conduits, connectors, junction boxes, receptacle boxes, etc.
- Light switches and dimmers *new*
- Duplex receptacles, GFCI receptacles, utility and appliance receptacles, USB jacks *new*
- Switch and receptacle covers
- Plugs and connectors
- Doorbells
- Smart security systems *new and in package*
- Electrical wire – non-metallic wire, single-strand wire, ac/mc metallic cable *No media cable, min 25'*
- Thermostats: digital only *New and in packaging*

Electronics

Electronic items must be fully operational and functional with all power and patch cords manuals included, if possible.

Unfortunately, ReStore no longer accepts TVs more than 5 years old. We no longer accepts desktops, laptops, or computer monitors.

- Blu-ray/DVD/CD players
- Functional VCR, cassette, 8-track, and vinyl record players
- Digital stereo equipment: receivers, speakers *Working*
- Electronic keyboards
- Radios
- Video games
- Televisions: smart and high definition digital, flat screen only. *No tube televisions*

Fans

Clean and fully operational with all installation hardware and no missing parts, manuals are appreciated.

- Ceiling fans
- Ceiling fan light sets with all globes
- Bathroom ventilation fans
- Gable vent fans
- Floor and table fans

Fencing

- Chain link fabric, gates, top rail *good condition*
- Wooden: in panels, any height, no rot or deterioration, good structural condition
- Vinyl: full pieces or panels only, no damage
- All posts- structurally sound, unbent, clean with no concrete attached
- All other new fencing materials: field, chicken wire, hardware cloth, erosion fence, etc. No rust, major tears, or other serious damage

Fireplaces and Accessories

- Fireplaces/wood stoves *TBD by store manager*
- Accessories must be clean and rust free

Flooring

Carpeting, area rugs, hardwood, vinyl, linoleum, granite, and marble flooring

- Carpet *New*
- Area rugs *New or gently used; used must be cleaned*
- Carpet tile *New or gently used*
- Flooring: engineered and hardwood; laminate; linoleum; ceramic, granite and marble tiles, new and unused flooring; at least 50sf must be the same. All flooring should be boxed/bundled. Original packaging preferred.
- Ceramic, granite and marble tile—three case minimum.

Furniture

Must be in gently used to new condition. No rips, stains, peeling, tears, broken springs, smoking/pet odors or pet damage. No sleeper sofas, mattresses or foundations.

- Antique furniture
- Head/foot boards *With frames is preferred*
- Bed frames *Full set only*
- Bureaus/dressers/clothing armoires
- Kitchen and dining tables and chairs
- Buffet servers/sideboards *as part of set*
- Upholstered furniture - sofas, recliners, love seats, ottomans, etc
- Chairs, rockers, and benches
- Coffee/end tables
- Conference tables
- Desks 3' x 5' or smaller *No executive desks or cubicles*



- Small game tables
- Office chairs
- Drafting tables
- File cabinets
- Bookshelves
- Storage cabinets
- Chests and trunks
- Decorative clocks
- Mirrors *Must be framed*
- Desk/floor lamps with intact shades or globes
- Outdoor Furniture *No fabric dry rot or broken frames*

Hardware

- Window hardware: sash locks and lifts, tilt latches, crank handles
- Door knobs: passage, privacy, deadbolts, keyed entry *Please include and bag keys, latch plates, and screws. Should be free from rust*
- Door hinges: complete sets with screws and hinge pins - bagged, free from rust
- Anchors, screws and nails *Preferably full, unopened boxes, must be sorted by type, rust free*
- Machine and carriage bolts
- Metal joist hangers, ties and plates
- Casters
- Rope, cord, and wire

Heating/Ventilation/AC

HVAC/Plumbing Supplies: Less than 2 years old;

- Duct - All types; 2' sections and longer, little rust or corrosion
- Flooring, ceiling, and return vents and covers *Clean and in good condition, no rust*
- Air conditioners (window) *5 years old or less, perfect working order needing no repair or parts*
- Air conditioners (central outdoor unit) *3 years old or less, perfect working order needing no repair or parts, well-maintained, w/ matching evaporator a-coil if separate*
- Furnaces – gas or electric *Perfect working order needing no repair or parts, inner workings, rust-free, 80% or above efficiency, operators, manuals included*
- Furnaces, hot water heaters, swamp coolers, and fans *Good working order, less than 10 years old.*

Home and Office

Items must have no visible signs of damage and should be cleaned before donating.

- Artwork *Framed prints, paintings, sculptures, picture frames, wall hangings*
- Decorative accessories *Memorabilia, knickknacks, decorative glassware, artificial greenery, vases*
- Mirrors *Framed mirrors only*
- Office and school supplies
- Outside décor items, fountains
- Vertical blinds *Wrapped and secure*

Insulation

- Rolls or batts of insulation *R-13 and up, new bags*
- Blown insulation *New bags only*
- Insulation support wires in box
- Rigid foam *½ sheet minimum*

Lighting

Light fixtures must be complete, in working condition and all hardware must be included.

- Chandeliers/pendant lights
- Vanity lights
- Desk/floor lamps with intact shades or globes
- Sconces and wall lamps
- Exterior residential light fixtures
- Track lighting *New and in packaging*
- Fluorescent light fixture *New led T-8 or T-5 and in packaging, no T-12 – discontinued in 2012*
- Recessed light fixture *New and in packaging*

Lumber and Sheet Goods

Lumber must be straight, clean, free of rot and insect damage, without nails/screws

- Milled lumber *6' lengths or greater*
- Trim/molding *4' lengths or greater*
- Sheet goods: plywood, osb, drywall, hardboard, cement board. *Minimum ½ sheet 4'x4'*
- Exotic woods and hardwoods

Masonry

Landscaping brick, stone, fencing, cinderblock, slate, cultured stone: these are drop-off only donations and minimum amount to donate is 20 pieces.

- Wall, veneer, and landscape *Must be relatively clean with little debris, little or no mortar*
- Paving stone and gravel *New, in bags*
- Bricks *Whole, intact, in good condition, free of mortar*
- Concrete and cinder blocks *Whole, intact, in good condition, free of mortar*



Paint Supplies

- Paint sprayers *Fully functional and thoroughly cleaned*
- Unused brushes, stirrers, rollers, paint cups and liners, and paint trays
- Unopened cans of paint *No rust with labels*
- Latex paint/water-based stain *Less than 1 year old, never opened and stored inside*

Plumbing Fixtures and Hardware

- Water heaters *6 years or newer*
- Pipe *New pvc, pex, galvanized, steel, and copper, including supplies and fittings*
- Sinks *Normal wear and tear, no cracks, chips or deep scratches in finish, no rust, hardware removed*
- Kitchen sinks *Self rimming or under mount, stainless steel, porcelain, stone. No cast iron*
- Utility sinks *Stainless steel or composite*
- Bathroom wall mount *With hanger*
- Bathroom bowl *New or used porcelain or composite. No cast iron or steel*
- Pedestal sinks: new and used *Neutral colors only. No chips, cracks, 'spider veins' in bowl*
- Vanity tops: new and used *Single and double bowl, neutral colors only, nothing out-dated glitter swirls. No chips, cracks, spider veins in bowl or excessive wear*
- Bathtubs *In like-new condition*
- Toilets: 1.6 Gallon flush or less *Cleaned and like new, white or bone, must be complete and assembled with no wax ring. No used unattached toilet seats.*
- Bath accessories *Complete with any brackets and hardware: towel bars and rings, soap dishes, toilet paper holders, toothbrush holders, tissue boxes, robe hooks*
- Kitchen, bath, and utility faucets *Clean, gently used, with all installation components*

Recreational Equipment

- Adult and children's bicycles *Clean, fully functional*
- Camping equipment *Must be in usable condition*
- Barbeque grills *New only*
- Sports equipment *Good condition, no swing sets, weapons or ammunition*
- Exercise and fitness equipment *Fully functional with no missing or damaged parts*
- Tabletop games *Good condition with all parts*

Roofing Materials and Gutters

Rolls of roofing material—mineral, felt, synthetic, 1/2 roll minimum

- New ridge caps and drip edges in full pieces
No rust or damage
- New asphalt shingles *Unopened, non-damaged bundles*
- New corrugated roof panels
- New metal gutters and fittings in full pieces
No dents or bends

Tools

Hand and bench power tools in good working condition with all parts, safety guards, cords, chargers and batteries, manuals if possible

- Fully functional and clean power lawn care tools—lawn mowers, blowers, edgers in new or good condition *Include manual, if possible*
- Hand tools—home, construction, mechanic
- Garden and lawn care tools *No rust*
- Antique tools *Good condition*

Vinyl Siding

Siding and soffit panels in whole boxes, dry

- Corners and F/J/H channels, 6' or longer
- Starter strips, metal and vinyl, 6' or longer

Windows

Windows must be clean, in new or like new condition, glass intact, no damaged or rotted wood, with fully functional tracks and hardware. Dual-pane with no fogging, wood or vinyl for new construction or retrofit windows, no aluminum windows or awnings

- Windows must be under 6'x6' (36sq ft) in size
- Stained glass windows
- Wood and vinyl shutters, interior and exterior
- Blinds must be wood or faux wood without cords
- Rolls of replacement screening

The fine print

Because Thomasville-Thomas County Habitat For Humanity is a registered 501(c)(3) organization. Donating goods to the ReStore could qualify you for a tax deduction. For donations valued at less than \$250, you will be handed a donation receipt letter request form that may be used as a receipt for your donation. If you wish to receive a donation receipt letter, please provide an itemized list of those items for which you wish to claim a tax deduction. This can be submitted when the donation is picked up or dropped off at the Thomasville ReStore location. If the value of the donation is greater than \$5,000, an independent appraisal is required and Habitat's staff is required to sign the IRS Form 8283 acknowledging receipt of the gift. To be acceptable to the IRS, the appraisal must be made no more than 60 days before the date of the contribution and before the due date of the tax return.
